

PRICES ORDER No. 153

being

A PRICES ORDER relating to the maximum retail price for Safety Matches.

Made by a Deputy Price Controller under the provisions of the *Prices Regulation Act* 1949, as amended to date, to come into operation on the date of publication in the *National Gazette*.

1. CITATION.

This Order may be cited as Prices Order No. 153.

2. REVOCATION.

Prices Order No. 137 is hereby revoked.

3. VARIATION TO PRICES ORDERS Nos. 117 AND 118.

- (i) Prices Order No. 117 is hereby amended by omitting from the Schedule to that Order the words:—
 "Matches 7"; and
- (ii) Prices Order No. 118 is hereby amended by omitting from the Schedule to that Order the words:—
 "Matches $17\frac{1}{2}$ 10".

4. DEFINITIONS.

In this Order—

"safety matches" means safety matches manufactured in Papua New Guinea, namely "National" and "King" brands;

"box" means a box containing an average of fifty (50) matches;

"retail" means for the purpose of consumption or use.

5. MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICE.

The maximum price at which safety matches may be sold by retail at any location in Papua New Guinea is three (3) toea a box.

6. DISPLAY OF PRICES.

A person or organisation who has in his custody or under his control any safety matches to which this Order applies, for sale by retail, or who offers, exhibits or exposes any of those safety matches for sale by retail, shall display a ticket, label, placard or notice attached to or exhibited or displayed with those safety matches setting forth in a prominent position in clear and legible figures easily discernable to any person inspecting such safety matches, the price at which the matches concerned may be bought, namely three (3) toea a box.

Following the grant of a lease an additional fee for the preparation of lease document, the amount of tender less the upset price where applicable and, it surveyed, the prescribed survey fee shall be payable within two (2) months from the date of grant. two (2) months from the date of grant.

Surveys fees to the value of K200 in the case of Portions 42 and 493, and K300 in the case of Portion 50 are payable by the successful applicant upon grant.
