

- (b) by omitting from Column 1 of the Schedule the Village Court named Pelibohuai and inserting in its place the name Pelipowai; and
- (c) by omitting from Column 1 of the Schedule the Village Court named Mataworei and inserting in its place the name Metaworei; and
- (d) by omitting from Column 1 of the Schedule the Village Court named Pityiluh and inserting in its place the name Pityilu.
