*Public Services Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1969**Teaching Service Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1971***APPOINTMENT OF BOARD OF INQUIRY AND TERMS OF REFERENCE**

I, John Guise, G.C.M.G., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 10 of the *Public Services Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1969* and Section 10 of the *Teaching Service Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1971* and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby—

- (a) establish a Board of Inquiry to consist of the persons specified in the Schedule; and
- (b) direct the Board of Inquiry to inquire into and report on the salary structure and conditions of employment of non-citizen public employees other than—
- (i) former Australian Staffing Assistance Group employees who are or may be employed until 31st December, 1978 by the State under contract in accordance with Parts XI and XII of the Australian Staffing Assistance Association of Papua New Guinea Terms and Conditions of Employment Determination registered under the *Public Services Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1969* on 2nd March 1976 and numbered No. 3 of 1976; and
  - (ii) auxiliary members of the Teaching Service; and
- (c) direct that in the light of the Government's national aims and objectives, the Board of Inquiry may make recommendations as to—
- (i) changes it may consider appropriate and consistent with the need for the future recruitment and retention of non-citizen public employees (including former Australian Staffing Assistance Group employees who may wish to be employed after 31st December, 1978 by the State and including auxiliary members of the Teaching Service); and
  - (ii) the desirability or otherwise of introducing a mechanism for, or method of, regularly reviewing the terms of employment of non-citizen public employees consistent with the need to maintain good industrial relations between public employees and public employers in line with the spirit and intentions of the existing industrial laws; and
- (d) direct that, to the extent that any of the matters specified in paragraphs (b) and (c) relate to the Teaching Service, those matters are referred to the Board of Inquiry.
