

*Animal Disease and Control Act 1952*

**RESTRICTION ON IMPORTATION AND INTRODUCTION OF POULTRY AND POULTRY PRODUCTS**

I, BOYAMO SALI, Minister for Primary Industry, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 21(a) of the *Animal Disease and Control Act 1952*, and all other powers me enabling, hereby prohibit the introduction or importation into Papua New Guinea of poultry of all kinds (including poultry products and eggs of poultry) originating from Australia, except with the approval of the Chief Quarantine Officer.
