EXTENSION OF ELECTION PERIOD—ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF THE EAST NEW BRITAIN
PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT

Industrial Relations Act 1962

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DECLARE COMMON RULE

I, Tore Lokoloko, G.C.M.G., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 36 of the *Industrial Relations Act 1962* and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby give notice that it is proposed to—

- (a) repeal the notice of Declaration of Common Rules dated 6th December, 1973 and published in *Government Gazette* No. 112 of 13th December, 1973 in so far as it relates to the Port Moresby General Employment Award 1973 (No. 16 of 1973); and
- (b) declare that Award as varied by the Port Moresby General Employment (Amending) Award 1975 (No. 13 of 1975) to be a common rule in relation to the area specified in Schedule 1 and the employees specified in Schedule 2 employed in that area.

SCHEDULE 1

In an area commencing at a point on the coastline at the most westerly point of Portion 517 thence by a straight line to the most westerly point of Portion 482 thence by a straight line to the north-eastern corner of Portion 483 thence by a straight line to the beacon on Mt Lawes thence by a straight line to the most easterly point of Portion 419 thence by a straight line to the north-eastern corner of Portion 115 thence by a straight line to the mouth of the Bomana Creek thence bounded generally on the east and the south-west by the coastline to the point of commencement except that Tatana Island, Napa Napa and Gemo shall be included.

SCHEDULE 2

1. All persons employed in that area except employees engaged—

- (a) directly in primary production; or
- (b) in domestic duties; or
- (c) under any other Act in force in Papua New Guinea other than those employees classified as General Labourers and Class 1, 2 and 3 occupations as determined by the Minimum Wages Board Determination No. 4 of 1974.

Central Banking Act 1973

DESCRIPTION OF CURRENCY

IN accordance with Section 51(2) of the *Central Banking Act 1973* the Bank of Papua New Guinea gives notice of the issue of a new K20 currency note, the characteristics of which are set out in the Schedule.

- Design Obverse—the central feature is a reproduction of the Papua New Guinea National Emblem together with local art lineal patterns surrounding and incorporated into the value numerals. These main items are produced by the multicolour intaglio process overprinted on a background of lineal patterns in multicoloured form.
- Reverse—the main feature is a montage portraying a 3/4 view of a Boar's head together with three items of intrinsic value used for trading purposes in Papua New Guinea. The main features are printed by the monocolour intaglio process overprinted on a background of lineal patterns printed in multicolour.
- It is predominately red in colour with the main features printed in dark brown, scarlet and red.

I, Tore Lokoloko, G.C.M.G., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 36 of the *Industrial Relations Act 1962* and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby give notice that it is proposed to declare the Papua New Guinea Trade Union Congress General Employment (Amending) Award (Award No. 12 of 1975) to be a common rule varying each award specified in Column 1 of the Schedule and declared to be a common rule as specified in Column 2, in relation to each area specified in Column 3 and the following employees in each of those areas:—

(a) all persons employed in each of those areas except employees engaged—
