## PRICES ORDER No. 205

being

A Prices Order relating to the maximum retail price for

## PETROL, DISTILLATE AND LIGHTING KEROSENE

MADE by the Deputy Price Controller under the provisions of the *Prices Regulation Act 1949*, to come into operation on the 29th September, 1977.

## 1. CITATION.

This Order may be cited as Prices Order No. 205.

## 2. REVOCATION.

Prices Orders Number 192, Number 196, Number 200 and Number 202 are hereby revoked.

## 3. DEFINITIONS.

In this Order—

- "petrol" includes any substance normally sold as petrol whether or not containing additives of any kind;
- "distillate" includes any substance normally sold as automotive distillate whether or not containing additives of any kind;
- "kerosene" includes any substance normally sold as kerosene being a medium refined petroleum product as used for lighting and cooking in home appliances, whether or not containing additives of any kind;
- "wholesaler" in relation to petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene means a person or a firm who sells petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene for the purpose of resale and not for the purpose of use;
- "supplier" in relation to petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene, means a person or a firm who sells petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene for the purpose of use;
- "retail" means for the purpose of consumption or use.

## 4. MAXIMUM PRICE.

(i) Subject to Subclause (ii) of this clause, where petrol, distillate or kerosene is supplied—

- (a) at a locality specified in the First Column of the Schedule to this Order; or
- (b) at some other place at which the petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene is transported from any such locality by or on behalf of a wholesaler or supplier;

## Prices Order No. 205—continued

the maximum price per gallon at which the petrol, distillate or kerosene may be supplied is the sum of—

(c) the maximum retail selling price specified in the Second, Third or Fourth Column as the case may be, of the Schedule in relation to the locality concerned; and

(d) the amount (if any) charged for the transport referred to in paragraph (b) of this subclause.

(ii) Where the maximum price of any quantity of petrol, distillate or kerosene supplied at any one time, calculated in accordance with Subclause (i) of this clause, is an amount involving a fraction of a toea the supplier may charge to the next whole toea.

## 5. SUPPLY TO GOVERNMENT, ETC.

Nothing in this Order applies to or relates to the supply of petrol, distillate or kerosene to the Government or instrumentality or authority of the Government.

## 6. DISPLAY OF PRICES.

A person or an organisation engaged in selling petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene by retail shall display in each of the places of business in prominent positions and in large, clear and legible figures the maximum prices at which such petrol, distillate and kerosene may be bought.
