## Organic Law on the Terms and Conditions of Employment of Judges

## REVOCATION OF DETERMINATIONS AND DETERMINATION OF SALARY AND OTHER CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT OF JUDGES OF THE NATIONAL COURT

I, Kingsford Dibela, Acting Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the Organic Law on the Terms and Conditions of Employment of Judges and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council given after receiving a report from the Public Services Commission, hereby—

- (a) revoke the Determinations of Salary and other Conditions of Employment of the Judges of the National Court dated 5th January, 1976 and 6th April, 1977; and
- (b) determine that the salary and other conditions of employment of the Judges of the National Court who are non-citizens are as set out in the Schedule.

## SCHEDULE

| Salary and other conditions including leave and housing .... | Equal to—<br>(a) an exempt employee of the Public Service employed on contract at Level 4, as varied from time to time; or<br>(b) an exempt employee of the Public Service employed on contract on ex-ASAG conditions at Level 4, as varied from time to time, as appropriate according to the particular category of employment of the occupant. |
| Furniture .....  | Items of furniture to be provided free of charge, on a scale appropriate to that of Departmental Head in the Public Service.  |
| Telephone .....  | Official telephone to be provided in the Judge's residence and the cost of all official calls to be met by the Government and the cost of private calls to be met by the Judge.   |
| Recreation Leave Fares .....                                 | Economy class return fares between Port Moresby and the Capital City of the Judge's home state to be provided for the Judge, his wife and dependent children under 18 years of age (if any) once each year.   |
| Attendance at Law Conventions .....                          | Attendance on an official basis at Law Conventions shall be at the discretion of the Judicial and Legal Services Commission.  |
| Transport .....  | Adequate transport of a reasonable standard (with a driver) to be provided for official purposes within Port Moresby or when upon circuit within Papua New Guinea.  |
| Travel expenses—Judge's wife .....                           | The fares of the Judge's wife shall be provided when she accompanies the Judge on circuit. This provision shall not be utilized more than three times a year. No part of the wife's expenses other than the fares shall be met.   |
| Travelling allowance .....                                   | When travelling on official duty a travelling allowance is payable as follows:—<br>Within Papua New Guinea .... K10 per day in addition to accommodation and all meals.<br>Within Australia )<br>Elsewhere ) .... Current rates payable in Australia (kina equivalent).   |
