### *Public Service (Interim Arrangements) Act 1973*

#### NOTIFICATION OF APPROVAL OF REGISTRATION

IT is hereby notified in accordance with Section 54(12) of the *National Investment and Development Act 1974* that—

- (a) under Sections 54(9) and 56(10) of the Act the Minister approved the registration of Chimbu Lodge Pty Ltd (in this notification called "the Enterprise") in respect of the following activities:

#### SCHEDULE

##### *Conditions of Registration—Chimbu Lodge Pty Ltd*

1. In this Schedule, words and expressions have the meaning that they have in the Act.
2. Any application by the Enterprise to the Minister under any of these conditions shall be made in writing to NIDA.
3. The Enterprise shall keep all its books of account and other financial records in Papua New Guinea in the English language.
4. The Enterprise shall comply with all obligations and conditions under any law or regulation relating to the operation of tourist enterprises.
5. The registration of the Enterprise is for twenty years but may be extended by the Minister from time to time on the application of the Enterprise.
6. The Enterprise shall guide and assist Papua New Guinean enterprises in establishing businesses in activities ancillary to the registered activities.

7. The Enterprise shall use supplies and services available within Papua New Guinea preferably provided by Papua New Guineans provided that such supplies and services are readily available at prices and of a quality similar to those obtainable from other sources.

8. The Enterprise shall at all times conduct its operations in such a way as to minimise deleterious effects on the environment and shall abide by all reasonable standards laid down by the Minister responsible for environmental matters.

9. The Enterprise shall:

- (a) conduct its business in accordance with normal commercial practices employed in the hotel and accommodation industry; and
- (b) if requested by the Director of the Office of Tourism, consult with the Office of Tourism, prior to the setting of new tariffs and other related matters and shall carry out or comply with any reasonable directives of the Director in relation thereto.

10. The Enterprise shall not without the prior approval of the Minister establish a place of business in any location in Papua New Guinea other than Kundiawa.

The Enterprise will comply with all and any obligations and conditions relating to the training of employees and the localisation of its staff (including both employees and officers of the Enterprise) which may from time to time be laid down by the Department of Labour, Commerce and Industry or the Department of Transport, Works and Supply (or any other Departments which may succeed to the functions of either of these Departments) or prescribed or declared under the *Employment (Training and Regulation) Act 1971* as in force from time to time or under any other Act dealing with training and localisation of employees.

3. The Enterprise will use sources of supply and services within Papua New Guinea, preferably Papua New Guinean owned, unless the required supplies and services are not readily available at comparable prices and similar quality in Papua New Guinea.

4. The Enterprise will keep all its books of account and records in Papua New Guinea and in the English language.

5. Subject to the Act, the registration of the Enterprise is for fifteen years from the date of registration but may be extended from time to time by the Minister on the application of the Enterprise.

6. Any application by the Enterprise for approval of, or a determination by, the Minister required by or to be given in accordance with any of these terms and conditions shall be made in writing to NIDA.

## PRICES ORDER No. 216

being

A Prices Order relating to maximum retail price for

**MANUFACTURED CIGARETTES**

MADE by a Deputy Price Controller under the provisions of the *Prices Regulation Act 1949*, to come into operation on the date of publication in the *National Gazette*.

**1. CITATION.**

This Order may be cited as Prices Order No. 216.

**2. REVOCATION.**

Prices Orders Numbers 181, 194 and 209 are hereby revoked.

**3. DEFINITIONS.**

In this Order—

“cigarettes” means cigarettes which are manufactured in Papua New Guinea from imported or locally grown tobacco leaf;

“retail” means for the purpose of consumption or use.

**4. MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICE.**

Subject to Section 5 of this Order—

(a) the maximum price per packet at which cigarettes may be sold by retail at any of the locations specified in Schedule 1 is the amount specified in the second column of Schedule 2 in relation to the brand and pack specified opposite in the first column of Schedule 2.

(b) the maximum price per packet at which cigarettes may be sold by retail at locations other than those specified in Schedule 1 is the amount specified in the third column of Schedule 2 in relation to the brand and pack specified in the first column of Schedule 2.

**5. EFFECT OF RETAIL SALES TAX.**

Where cigarettes are sold in a locality which is subject to a retail sales tax lawfully imposed in respect of the Province in which that locality is situated, the maximum price at which cigarettes may be sold by retail at that locality is the relevant price referred to in Section 4 of this Order plus the amount of provincial retail tax per packet.

**6. DISPLAY OF PRICES.**

A person or organization who has in his custody or under his control any of the cigarettes to which this Order applies for sale by retail, or who offers, exhibits or exposes any of those cigarettes for sale by retail, shall display a ticket, label, placard or notice attached to or exhibited or displayed with cigarettes setting forth in a prominent position in clear and legible figures easily discernible to any person inspecting such cigarettes the price at which the cigarettes concerned may be bought.

**7. MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES OF CIGARETTES IN CERTAIN AREAS.**

Notwithstanding anything in this Order, where a notice in writing is given by the Controller to a supplier of cigarettes fixing the maximum price at which cigarettes may be supplied by him in any locality, being a price not less than fixed by Section 4 of this Order, the maximum price at which cigarettes may be supplied is the price fixed in that notice.

## PRICES ORDER No. 217

being

A Prices Order relating to the maximum retail price for

## PETROL, DISTILLATE AND LIGHTING KEROSENE

MADE by the Deputy Price Controller under the provisions of the *Prices Regulation Act 1949*, to come into operation on the date of publication in the *National Gazette*.

## 1. CITATION.

This Order may be cited as Prices Order No. 217.

## 2. REVOCATION.

Prices Order Number 212 is hereby revoked.

## 3. DEFINITIONS.

In this Order—

“petrol” includes any substance normally sold as petrol whether or not containing additives of any kind;

“distillate” includes any substance normally sold as automotive distillate whether or not containing additives of any kind;

“kerosene” includes any substance normally sold as kerosene being a medium refined petroleum product as used for lighting and cooking in home appliances, whether or not containing additives of any kind;

“wholesaler” in relation to petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene means a person or a firm who sells petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene for the purpose of resale and not for the purpose of use;

“supplier” in relation to petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene, means a person or a firm who sells petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene for the purpose of use;

## 4. MAXIMUM PRICE.

- (i) Subject to Subclause (ii) of this clause, where petrol, distillate or kerosene is supplied—
- (a) at a locality specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order; or
- (b) at some other place at which the petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene is transported from any such locality by or on behalf of a wholesaler or supplier;
- the maximum price per gallon at which the petrol, distillate or kerosene may be supplied is the sum of—
- (c) the maximum retail selling price specified in the Second, Third or Fourth Column, as the case may be, of the Schedule in relation to the locality concerned; and
- (d) the amount (if any) charged for the transport referred to in paragraph (b) of this subclause.
- (ii) Where the maximum price of any quantity of petrol, distillate or kerosene supplied at any one time, calculated in accordance with Subclause (i) of this clause is an amount involving a fraction of a toea, the supplier may charge to the next whole toea.

## 5. SUPPLY TO GOVERNMENT, ETC.

Nothing in this Order applies to or relates to the supply of petrol, distillate or kerosene to the Government or instrumentality or authority of the Government.

## 6. DISPLAY OF PRICES.

A person or an organisation engaged in selling petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene by retail shall display in each of the places of business in prominent positions and in large, clear and legible figures the maximum prices at which such petrol, distillate and kerosene may be bought.
