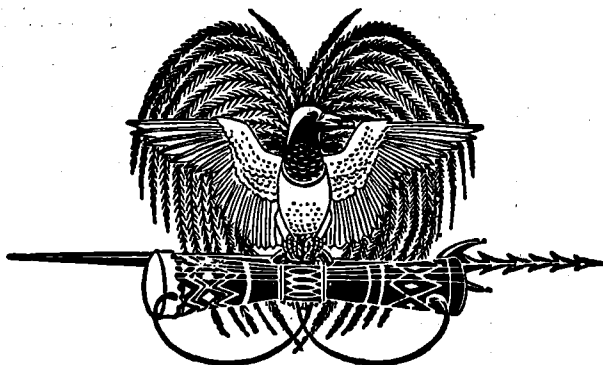

*Medical Services Act 1965***DELEGATION**

THE NURSING COUNCIL of Papua New Guinea, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 58 of the *Medical Services Act 1965* and all other powers it enabling, hereby—

- (a) revokes the notice of Delegation dated 1st February, 1974 and published in *Government Gazette* No. 19 of 14th March, 1974; and
- (b) delegates the following powers and functions under the *Medical Services Act 1965* to the Education Committee appointed under Section 57 of that Act:—
 - (i) all its powers and functions relating to the conduct of all basic and post basic nursing examinations; and
 - (ii) all its powers and functions relating to the setting of minimum standards of nursing courses both basic and post basic; and
 - (iii) all its powers and functions relating to the continuing review of nursing courses; and
 - (iv) all its powers and functions relating to the inspection of training schools.
