

Public Service Gazette

The Public Service issue contains notices concerning vacancies, transfers and promotions within the National Public Service. These issues are published monthly at 11.30 a.m. on the first Thursday of each month.

General Gazette

General notices issue includes the sittings of the National Parliament; Legislation (Acts assented to, Statutory Rules); Tenders etc. These issues are published weekly at 11.30 a.m. on Thursday.

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Special issues are made on urgent matters as required. Single copies are available on the day of issue at the Government Printing Office, Newtown, at 17 toea and are provided at no extra charge with weekly issues.

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"Notices for insertion" in the *General Gazette* must be received at the Government Printing Office, P.O. Box 3280, Port Moresby, before 12.00 noon on Friday, preceding the day of publication.

All notices from whatever source, must have a covering instruction setting out the publication details required. The notice must be an original. That is, not a carbon copy and not a photostat copy. The notice should be typewritten (double-spaced) and on one side of the paper only. Signatures in particular and proper names must be shown very plainly in the text. *Copy not submitted in accordance with these instructions will be returned unpublished.*

Public Finances Regulation 1974

REVOCATION AND APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF THE POSTS AND TELECOMMUNICATIONS SUPPLY AND TENDERS BOARD

I, Barry Blyth Holloway, Minister for Finance, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 17 of the Public Finances Regulation 1974 and all other powers me enabling and acting on the advice of the Secretary for Finance, hereby—

- (a) revoke the notice of Establishment of the Posts and Telecommunications Supply and Tenders Board dated 29th April, 1977 and published in *National Gazette* No. G38 of 12th May, 1977 in so far as it relates to the appointment of Members and Deputy Members of that Board; and
- (b) appoint each of the following persons to be Members of the Posts and Telecommunications Supply and Tenders Board—
 - (i) First Assistant Secretary, Telecommunications, Department of Public Utilities (Chairman); and
 - (ii) Principal Engineer, Mechanical and Electrical Engineering Branch, Department of Works and Supply; and
 - (iii) Assistant Secretary (Accounting Policy) Department of Finance; and
- (c) appoint a deputy for each of the following members of the Board—
 - (i) in the case of the First Assistant Secretary, Telecommunications, the Assistant Secretary, Engineering Services, Department of Public Utilities; and
 - (ii) in the case of the Principal Engineer, Mechanical and Electrical Engineering Branch, the Principal Engineer, General Engineering, Department of Works and Supply; and
 - (iii) in the case of the Assistant Secretary (Accounting Policy), the Senior Finance Officer (Operations), Department of Finance.

PRICES ORDER No. 223

being

A Prices Order relating to the maximum retail price for

PETROL, DISTILLATE AND LIGHTING KEROSENEMADE by the Deputy Price Controller under the provisions of the *Prices Regulation Act 1949*, to come into operation on the date of publication in the *National Gazette*.**1. CITATION.**

This Order may be cited as Prices Order No. 223.

2. REVOCATION.

Prices Orders Number 217 and Number 218 are hereby revoked.

3. DEFINITIONS.

In this Order—

- “petrol” includes any substance normally sold as petrol whether or not containing additives of any kind;
- “distillate” includes any substance normally sold as automotive distillate whether or not containing additives of any kind;
- “kerosene” includes any substance normally sold as kerosene being a medium refined petroleum product as used for lighting and cooking in home appliances, whether or not containing additives of any kind;
- “wholesaler” in relation to petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene means a person or a firm who sells petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene for the purpose of resale and not for the purpose of use;
- “supplier” in relation to petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene, means a person or a firm who sells petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene for the purpose of use;
- “retail” means for the purpose of consumption or use.

4. MAXIMUM PRICE.

(i) Subject to Subclause (ii) of this clause, where petrol, distillate or kerosene is supplied—

(a) at a locality specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order; or

(b) at some other place at which the petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene is transported from any such locality by or on behalf of a wholesaler or supplier;

the maximum price per gallon at which the petrol, distillate or kerosene may be supplied is the sum of—

(c) the maximum retail selling price specified in the Second, Third or Fourth Column as the case may be, of the Schedule in relation to the locality concerned; and

(d) the amount (if any) charged for the transport referred to in paragraph (b) of this subclause.

(ii) Where the maximum price of any quantity of petrol, distillate or kerosene supplied at any one time, calculated in accordance with Subclause (i) of this clause is an amount involving a fraction of a toea, the supplier may charge to the next whole toea.

5. SUPPLY TO GOVERNMENT ETC.

Nothing in this Order applies to or relates to the supply of petrol, distillate or kerosene to the Government or instrumentality or authority of the Government.

6. DISPLAY OF PRICES.

A person or an organisation engaged in selling petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene by retail shall display in each of the places of business in prominent positions and in large, clear and legible figures the maximum prices at which such petrol, distillate and kerosene may be bought.
