

National Investment and Development Act 1974

NOTIFICATION OF APPROVAL OF REGISTRATION

IT is hereby notified in accordance with Section 54(12) of the *National Investment and Development Act 1974* that—

- (a) under Sections 54(9) and 56(10) of the Act the Minister approved the registration of Halla Cement (PNG) Pty Limited (in this notification called "the Enterprise") in respect of the following activities:

- (b) The registration shall cease if without the consent of NIDA the Enterprise has not submitted to the Minister within eight months of the date of registration an environmental impact study.
- (c) The registration shall cease if without the consent of NIDA the Enterprise has not completed within nine months of the date of registration all arrangements and agreements on all matters necessary for the project to proceed. Such matters will include:

- (d) The registration shall cease if without the consent of NIDA the Enterprise has not commenced site works within twelve months of the date of registration.

- (e) The registration shall cease if without the consent of NIDA the Enterprise has not commenced production within thirty-six months of the date of registration.
6. The Enterprise shall guide and assist Papua New Guinean enterprises in establishing businesses in ancillary activities.
7. The Enterprise shall use supplies and services available within Papua New Guinea, preferably provided by Papua New Guineans, provided that such supplies and services are readily available at prices and of a quality similar to those obtainable from other sources, but:
- (a) The Enterprise shall not without the prior approval of NIDA enter into any agreements for the distribution of cement within Papua New Guinea.
- (b) The Enterprise shall not without the prior approval of NIDA enter into any agreements for the supply of goods or services within Papua New Guinea.
8. The Enterprise shall at all times conduct its operations in such a way as to minimise deleterious effects on the environment and shall abide by any reasonable standards laid down by the Minister responsible for environmental matters.

Unless otherwise determined by the Minister, Papua New Guineans or local enterprises shall by the seventh anniversary of the date of registration and at all times thereafter hold and beneficially own shares having the right to not less than 76% of the votes at a general meeting of the Enterprise and the right to appoint directors of the Enterprise not less than in proportion to their equity holding.
