*Liquor (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1973***EXEMPTION FROM PROHIBITION ON THE ADVERTISING OF LIQUOR**

- (b) exempt any advertisement, statement, writing, notice, photograph or picture containing words, letters, devices, signs, symbols or colours being, or indicating the name or business name of a brewery set out in the Schedule from the provisions of Section 5 of the Act, the operation of which has been extended so as to include ale, beer, porter, stout, cider or perry within the definition of "liquor" for the purposes of that section, subject to the conditions (if any) specified in that Schedule.
