## STATUTORY INSTRUMENT No. OF 1979

Fauna (Protection and Control) (Maza Wildlife Management Area) Rules 1979

MADE by the Minister after consultation with the Maza Wildlife Management Committee under the *Fauna (Protection and Control) Act 1966*.

## 1. INTERPRETATION.

In these Rules, unless the contrary intention appears—

“the Area” means the Maza Wildlife Management Area.

## 2. TRADITIONAL HAND-HARPOON METHOD MAY BE USED.

A person may at any time take or catch a dugong within the Area by the traditional hand-harpoon method from a canoe, whether powered by outboard engine or otherwise.

## 3. RESTRICTION ON NETTING DUGONGS.

(1) A person shall not take or catch a dugong within the Area by means of a net except—

(a) during the months of May, June and July; and

(b) in the immediate area of Daru Island.

(2) Where a net is used to take or catch a dugong the mesh size shall not exceed ten inches.

## 4. BEST ENDEAVOURS NOT TO TAKE, ETC., MOTHER OR BABY.

A person shall use his best endeavour not to take, catch or kill within the area a mother dugong or a baby dugong.

## 5. SELLING OF DUGONGS.

(1) A dugong taken or caught within the area may only be sold in the market at Daru.

(2) Where a person intends to sell a dugong in the market at Daru he shall, prior to offering it for sale, bring it to the Daru Wildlife Division Dugong Project Office for inspection by—

(a) a Wildlife Officer; or

(b) a member of the Maza Wildlife Management Committee; or

(c) any person authorised by a Wildlife Officer or member of the Maza Wildlife Management Committee.

## 6. PENALTY.

A person who, without reasonable cause (the burden of proof of which is on him), contravenes or fails to comply with a provision of these Rules is liable to the appropriate penalties set out in the Act.

## EXEMPTION

I, Pato Kakarya, Minister for the Environment and Conservation, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 25A of the *Fauna (Protection and Control) Act 1966* and all other powers me enabling and being of the opinion that it is, in the circumstances of Papua New Guinea, expedient to do so, hereby—

(a) exempt automatic citizens resident in the Daru Subprovince of the Western Province, from the provisions of Part III of that Act in respect of Dugong dugon (declared a protected fauna under Section 10); and

(b) fix that the period of exemption is one year commencing on and from the date of publication of this instrument in the *National Gazette*; and

(c) impose that the taking or killing of dugong must comply with the provisions of the Fauna (Protection and Control) (Maza Wildlife Management Area) Rules 1978 made under the *Fauna (Protection and Control) Act 1966*.

  4. The Enterprise shall keep all its books of account and other financial records in Papua New Guinea in the English language.
  5. The Enterprise shall guide and assist Papua New Guinean enterprises in establishing businesses in activities ancillary to the registered activities.
  6. The Enterprise shall use supplies and services available within Papua New Guinea, preferably provided by Papua New Guineans provided that such supplies and services are readily available at prices and of a quality similar to those obtainable from other sources.
  7. The Enterprise shall at all times conduct its operations in such a way as to minimise deleterious effects on the environment and shall abide by any reasonable standards specified by the Minister responsible for environmental matters.

The Enterprise shall comply with all and any obligations and conditions relating to the employment of non-citizens, training of employees and the localisation of its staff (including both employees and officers of the Enterprise) which may from time to time be laid down by the Department of Labour, Commerce and Industry (or any other Department which succeeds to the functions of that Department) or prescribed or declared under the *Employment (Training and Regulation) Act 1971* or under any other Act dealing with employment of non-citizens, training and localisation of employees.

5. Unless otherwise determined by the Minister, Papua New Guineans or local enterprises shall by the third anniversary of the date of registration and at all times thereafter own and control not less than 25% of the Enterprise.

6. Subject to the Act, the registration of the Enterprise is for five years from the date of registration but may be extended from time to time by the Minister on the application of the Enterprise.

7. If at the expiration of six months from the date of registration the Enterprise has not commenced carrying on business in any of the activities for which it is hereby registered, the registration of the Enterprise shall thereupon cease and determine in respect of those activities.

8. The Enterprise shall use sources of supply and services within Papua New Guinea, preferably Papua New Guinean owned, unless the required supplies and services are readily available at comparable prices and of similar quality in Papua New Guinea.

9. The Enterprise shall not register any transfer of its shares until NIDA has been notified in writing of the transfer.

10. The Enterprise shall not without the prior approval of the Minister carry on the activity for which it is registered in any location in Papua New Guinea other than Section 58, Lot 2, Waigani Drive, Hohola.

11. The Enterprise shall consult with Papua New Guinean employees before management decisions relating to the terms and conditions of employment of such employees are made.

12. Other than the manager, only Papua New Guineans shall be employed by the Enterprise unless prior approval to do otherwise is granted to the Enterprise by the Secretary for Labour, Commerce and Industry.
