DETERMINATION OF TITLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF MINISTERS

I, MICHAEL THOMAS SOMARE, Prime Minister, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 148(1) of the Constitution and all other powers me enabling, hereby -

- (a) revoke the Determination of Titles and Responsibilities of Ministers dated 23 May, 1979; and
- (b) determine that each Minister set out in Column 1 of each Schedule shall have -
 - (i) the title specified in Column 2; and
 - (ii) the responsibilities specified in Column 3; and
 - (iii) the responsibilities for administering the Acts (or part of an Act) specified in Column 4,

to come into effect on and from the date of signature of this instrument.


