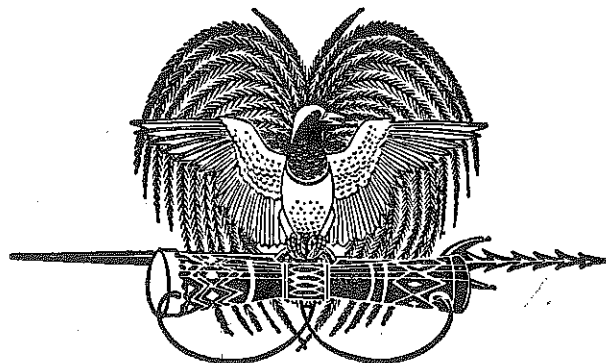
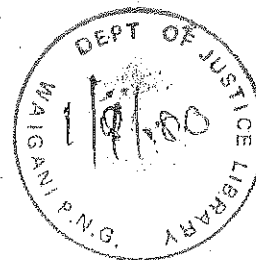

## PROCLAMATION

## Erave Local Government Council (Amendment) Proclamation 1980

being

A Proclamation to amend the Proclamation dated 4th April, 1966, and published in *Local Government Gazette* No. 5 of 9th May, 1966, as amended by the Proclamations specified in the Schedule.

MADE by the Head of State acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council under the *Local Government Act* 1963 after consultation with the Erave Local Government Council.

**1. WARDS.**

The Principal Proclamation is amended by adding at the end of paragraph (a) after Ward 13 and its description the following:—

“Ward 14. Waraga and Tono Village Groups.  
Ward 15. Pupitau and Boro Village Groups.  
Ward 16. Wapasali, Keba and Tumbadi Village Groups.”

**2. MEMBERSHIP.**

The Principal Proclamation is amended by omitting paragraph (b) and substituting:—

“(b) the Council consists of 25 Councillors, being three Councillors each for Wards 3 and 5 and two Councillors each for Wards 1, 4, 6, 10 and 13 and one Councillor for each of the remaining wards referred to in paragraph (a); and.”

**3. TENURE OF OFFICE OF COUNCILLORS.**

The President, Vice-President and Councillors in office immediately before the date of this Proclamation shall continue in office for the balance of the term of office for which they were elected.

3. Provide legal and technical advice and assistance to Provincial Governments in their commercial and business activities.
4. Administer local government under National legislation where this is in force. Provide advice and support to Provincial Governments on the development and administration of local level government.
5. Monitor Provincial Government organizational development; assist with management problem solving and the development of improved provincial management systems."; and

(b) adding at the end of Schedule 14 the following Schedule:—

"SCHEDULE 15*Department of Community and Family Services*

1. Responsible for the administration, standards, accreditation and monitoring of Welfare legislation.
2. Provide support and assistance to Provinces in respect of social services and juvenile institutions.
3. Ensure the involvement of youth in relevant aspects of social, economic and political development.
4. Ensure that women have the opportunity to participate in the Nation's development.
5. Meet the training needs of social development, welfare and provincial affairs officers.
6. Initiate research and planning for social impact studies and national projects and advise on the social consequences of development.
7. Provide liaison and advisory functions for Provincial Affairs field officers.
8. Provide administrative and advisory services in respect of land matters affecting the rights of traditional land owners.
9. Promotion of recreational activities."
