Organic Law on the Calling of Meetings of the Parliament

FIXING OF DATE OF MEETING OF PARLIAMENT

I, Tore Lokoloko, G.C.M.G., O.B.E., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 2(1)(a)(iii) of the Organic Law on the calling of Meetings of the Parliament and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council and being of the opinion that exceptional circumstances, namely, the consideration by Parliament of an urgent request from the Government of the New Hebrides to use Papua New Guinea Defence Force personnel to keep order in that country and for such other purposes, justify the urgent calling of a meeting of Parliament, hereby fix 2 o'clock in the afternoon of Tuesday, 5th August, 1980 as the time for holding next meeting of Parliament.

CONSTITUTION

AUTHORITY

I, Tore Lokoloko, G.C.M.G., O.B.E., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 205(1)(b) of the Constitution and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby authorize the sending of 150 members of the Papua New Guinea Defence Force to the New Hebrides for ceremonial purposes connected with the Independence celebrations in the New Hebrides, on the condition that those members do not engage in any other activities other than those required in connection with the Independence celebrations in the New Hebrides.
