

Judgements Enforcement (Reciprocal Arrangements) Act 1976

REVOCATION OF DECLARATION AND DECLARATION OF RECIPROCAL ARRANGEMENTS

I, Anthony Luke Bais, Minister for Justice, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 2 of the *Judgements Enforcement (Reciprocal Arrangements) Act 1976* and all other powers me enabling, hereby—

(a) revoke the following notices:—

- (i) the Declaration of Reciprocal Arrangement (Australia) dated 3rd March, 1977 and published in the *National Gazette* No. G25 of 17th March, 1977;
- (ii) the Amendment of Notice of Declaration of Reciprocal Arrangement (Australia) dated 6th May, 1977 and published in the *National Gazette* No. G39 of 19th May, 1977; and

(b) being satisfied that, in the event of the benefits conferred by Part II of that Act being extended to judgement given in the superior court of Australia and its following territories:—

- (i) Australia Capital Territory;
- (ii) Northern Territory;
- (iii) Norfolk Island,

substantial reciprocity of treatment will be assured as respects the enforcement in Australia and those territories of judgements given in the National Court, hereby declare—

- (iv) that Part II of that Act is extended to Australia and those territories; and
- (v) that the High Court of Australia, the Federal Court of Australia, the Supreme Court of each State of Australia, the Australian Capital Territory, the Northern Territory and the Norfolk Island shall be deemed superior courts of Australia and those territories for the purposes of Part II of that Act.
