EXEMPTION FROM IMPORT DUTY

I, Kingsford Dibela, G.C.M.G., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 8(1)(a) of the Customs (Tariff) Act 1983 and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby exempt from import duty the goods specified in the Schedule subject to the conditions specified therein.

(c) the use of standing gill nets with mesh size between 6.35 cm and 12.7 cm inclusive, from the mouth of the Binaturi River to Sui Village (Latitude 8 degrees 49 minutes (South) Longitude 143 degrees 25 minutes (East) from the low water mark to the high water mark from January to July inclusive.
