Public Holidays Act (Chapter 321)

APPOINTMENT OF PUBLIC HOLIDAYS

I, Kingsford Dibela, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 5 of the *Public Holidays Act* (Chapter 321) and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, on the occasion of His Royal Highness Prince Charles visit to Papua New Guinea, hereby declare—

- (a) 7th August, 1984 to be a public holiday throughout the National Capital District and the Central Province; and
- (b) 8th August, 1984 to be a public holiday throughout the Northern and East Sepik Provinces; and
- (c) 9th August, 1984 to be a public holiday throughout the Manus Province.

National Capital District Government (Preparatory Arrangements) Act 1982

REVOCATION AND APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL CAPITAL DISTRICT INTERIM COMMISSION

I, Kingsford Dibela, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Sections 4, 6(1) (c) and 6(1) (i) of the *National Capital District Government (Preparatory Arrangements) Act 1982* and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby in accordance with—

- (a) Section 6(1) (c) revoke the appointment of Maragu Tabu as a member of the National Capital District Interim Commission dated 22nd April, 1982; and
- (b) appoint William Lawrence to be a member of that Commission; and
- (c) Section 6(1) (i), revoke the appointment of Kepas Watangia as a member of the National Capital District Interim Commission dated 22nd April, 1982; and
- (d) appoint Jack Pidik to be a member of that Commission; and
- (e) reappoint Henry Fabila to be the Chairman of that Commission; and
- (f) reappoint Morris Alaluku to be the Deputy Chairman of that Commission.
