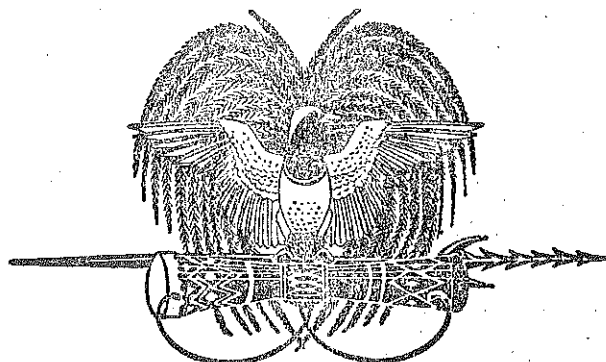

Defence Act (Chapter 74)

APPOINTMENT OF ACTING COMMANDER OF THE DEFENCE FORCE

Legislative Counsel Drafting Service Act (Chapter 80)

APPOINTMENT AND RE-APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATIVE DRAFTING SERVICE

I, Brown Sinamoi, Acting Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 5 of the *Legislative Drafting Service Act* (Chapter 80) and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby—

- (a) in accordance with Section 193(3) of the Constitution after consultation with the Public Services Commission, appoint Emmanuel Bigaveka Giyomatala to act as First Legislative Counsel for a period commencing on and from 1st January, 1987 during the absence on recreation leave of James Murdo Fraser; and
