Customs (Tariff) Act (Chapter 101A)

REDUCED RATE OF IMPORT DUTY

I, Kingsford Dibela, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 8(1)(b) of the *Customs (Tariff) Act* (Chapter 101A) and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby reduce to 7.5% the rate of import duty on all television studio apparatus imported by Media Niugini Proprietary Limited for a period of two years commencing on and from 1st January, 1987, provided that—

EXEMPTION FROM IMPORT DUTY

- (vi) that Niugini Television Network advise the Bureau of Customs of the proposed importation of the apparatus prior to despatch;

- (vii) that the total value of the apparatus be approximately K625 000;
 (viii) that the apparatus be imported prior to 13th May, 1987.
