Organic Law on the Number of Ministers

DETERMINATION AS TO NUMBER OF MINISTERS

I, Kingsford Dibela, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by the Organic Law on the Number of Ministers and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the Prime Minister, hereby—

- (a) revoke all previous Determinations as to Numbers of Ministers; and
