*Licensing of Heavy Vehicles Act (Chapter 367)***MAXIMUM FREIGHT RATES—SOUTHERN HIGHLANDS PROVINCE**

THE LAND TRANSPORT BOARD, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 22 of the *Licensing of Heavy Vehicles Act* (Chapter 367) and all other powers it enabling, after consultation with the Transport Committee, hereby—
