Forestry (Private Dealings) Act (Chapter 217)

DECLARATION OF LOCAL FOREST AREA

I, Karl Stack, Minister for Forests, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 4(1) of the *Forestry (Private Dealings) Act* (Chapter 217) and all other powers me enabling, and being satisfied that:—

- (a) it is proper to do so having regard to:—
- (i) the interest of the owners by custom of the timber in any land (including their interest in having their clan cleared and so enabling, agricultural development to take place on the land); and
 - (ii) the national interests; and
 - (iii) the prospects for the economic exploitation of the timber; and
- (b) the area is one suitable for exploitation under the Act,

hereby declare the area of land specified in the Schedule to be a Local Forest Area for the purposes of the Act.

SCHEDULE
