GENERAL PRICES (AMENDMENT No. 6) ORDER 1989

being

A General Prices Order.

MADE by the Deputy Price Controller under the *Prices Regulation Act* (Chapter 320) to come into operation on 3rd April, 1989.

1. NEW SECTION 19

The principal Order is amended by adding at the end of Section 18, the following new Sections:-

"19. POSTAL—MAXIMUM POSTAL CHARGES

- (1) In this section and in Schedule 14 unless the contrary intention appears—
 "postal services" refer to the provision of postal services both nationally (domestic) and internationally (overseas);
 "domestic postal services" means postal services provided either by airmail or surface mail from Papua New Guinea to overseas countries, as specified or categorised by the following zones:
- zone 1—Australia, New Zealand, Solomon Islands and Norfolk
 - zone 2—Asia/Pacific Region
 - zone 3—Others (not in zones 1 & 3)
- "facsimile service (kwik piksa leta)" refers to a form of telegraphy for the transmission of written materials or plans or illustrations by electronic means within PNG or beyond PNG as the Corporation shall from time to time determine.
 "money transfer services (salim moni kwik)" refers to an order transmitted by the Corporation by electronic means which entitles a payee or an authorised person to receive payment of a specific sum of money at a nominated post office within Papua New Guinea.
 "post office letter box and private bag service" refers to any receptacle created, installed or provided by PTC, into which postal articles may be put by public for conveyance and delivery through postal service.
- (2) The maximum postal charges are shown under columns 2 and 3 of Schedule 14 opposite the appropriate types of services as categorised in Column 1.

20. TELECOMMUNICATION CHARGES—MAXIMUM TELECOMMUNICATION CHARGES

- (1) In this section and in Schedule 15 unless the contrary intention appears—
 "telephone service" is referred to the provision of automatic telephone services. Specific areas covered include:
- "exchange line services" refers to telephone services via cable pair;
 - "telephone instruments and accessories" refers to the type of telephone hand-set and attachments used for telephone services;

20. Telecommunication Charges—Maximum Telecommunication Charges—continued

- “business communication equipment” refers to the type of business telephone service systems;
 - “PABX systems” means private automatic business exchange;
 - “radio services” refers to telephone services via radio;
 - “alteration removal charges” refers to charges levied on any changes or relocation to a telephone service;
 - “telephone call charges” refers to charges levied on the type of telephone calls made;
 - “telegraph service and telegram service” refer to the provision telex and telegraphic services;
 - “telegram service” refers to transmitting of message or data through post office, by telephone, or by telex;
 - “telex services alteration and removals” refers to charges levied on any changes or relocation to any telex service;
 - “leased telex equipment” refers to the rental of a telex equipment for a fixed period of time.
 - “leased lines and data service” is referred to the following areas:
 - “leased voice grade circuits” refers to the leasing of a point to point of dedicated line;
 - “leased data circuits” refers to the leasing of a point to point dedicated line by modems;
 - “data modems” refers to electronic devices used to activate transmission.
 - “facsimile equipment” refers to an equipment to transmit data.
- (2) The maximum telecommunications charges are shown under Columns 2 and 3 of Schedule 15 opposite the appropriate types of services shown in Column 1.
