National Land Registration Act (Chapter 357)

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 9

I, Kala Swokin, Minister for Lands and Physical Planning, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 9 of the *National Land Registration Act* (Chapter 357) and all other powers me enabling, hereby declare that the land specified in the Schedule being freehold land is National Land.

SCHEDULE
