**AMENDMENT OF PROCLAMATION OF CURFEW**

I, Dennis Young, C.M.G., Acting Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the *Curfew Act 1987* and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby, with effect on and from 13th October, 1989, amend the Proclamation of Curfew, in respect of the City of Lae and certain areas of the Morobe Province, as contained in the notice of Proclamation of Curfew dated 8th September, 1989 and published in the *National Gazette* No. G57, as follows:—

Delete from the notice the words and number "the hours of six o'clock in the evening (6 p.m.)" and substitute "the hours of eight o'clock in the evening (8 p.m.)".
