

**REVOCATION OF APPOINTMENT OF CHAIRMAN, DEPUTY CHAIRMAN, MEMBERS AND ALTERNATE MEMBERS OF THE POST AND TELECOMMUNICATION CORPORATION BOARD AND APPOINT A CHAIRMAN, DEPUTY CHAIRMAN, TWO MEMBERS AND RE-APPOINT A MEMBER**

I, Dennis Young, C.M.G., Acting Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Sections 7, 8 and 9 of the *Post and Telecommunication Corporation Act (Chapter 394)* as amended by the *Post and Telecommunication Corporation (Amendment) Act 1987* and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, given after consideration of recommendations by the Minister for Communications, hereby—

(a) revoke the appointments of—

- (v) Richard Pickworth as alternate member to Richard Koypoto, of the Board of the Post and Telecommunication Corporation,

on and from the date of gazettal of this instrument in the National Gazette; and

- (c) re-appoint Leslie Autang Wuten as a member under Section 7(2)(e) of the Board of the Post and Telecommunication Corporation with effect from 2nd April, 1990.
