**PROVISIONAL SUSPENSION OF NORTH SOLOMONS PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT**

I, the NATIONAL EXECUTIVE COUNCIL, by virtue of the powers contained in Section 187E(1) of the *Constitution* and Section 91A of the *Organic Law on Provincial Government*, having considered a report from the Minister of Provincial Government, in the opinion that a ground for suspension exists and that the matter can only be put right by suspension, provisionally suspends the North Solomons Provincial Government with effect from 4.06 p.m. on 29th August,

CONSTITUTION

EXERCISE OF POWERS OF THE NATIONAL EXECUTIVE COUNCIL
