

Prime Minister Act (Chapter 27)

APPOINTMENT OF ACTING PRIME MINISTER

I, WIWA KOROWI, G.C.M.G., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 143(1) of the Constitution and Section 3(2) of the *Prime Minister Act* (Chapter 27) and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council hereby appoint Michael Somare, a Minister, to be the Acting Prime Minister for a period commencing on and from 3rd December, 1991 until the return from overseas of the Deputy Prime Minister.

REVOCATION OF APPOINTMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF DEPARTMENTAL HEAD

Organic Law on Provincial Government
