


*Customs (Tariff) Act* (Chapter 101A)

### REDUCED RATE OF IMPORT DUTY

I, Dennis Young, C.M.G., Acting Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 9(1)(b) of the *Customs (Tariff) Act*, 1990 and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby reduce to the average rate of import duty from time to time payable on the items listed in the description of goods specified in Column 2 of Schedule 1 the rate of import duty on all items specified in Schedule 2 which are imported solely by the Kutubu Joint Venture, to the exclusion of all contractors and sub-contractors, which but for this reduction would have attracted a higher rate of import duty, with effect from the date of publication of this instrument in the National Gazette.

SCHEDULE 2

Specialised plant, machinery, equipment, explosives vehicles, chemicals, fuels, supplies or other assets, including any parts of which, at the time when such duty is sought to be imposed:

- (a) is imported solely for the purpose of implementing the Petroleum Development Project; and
- (b) is specifically, or has been generally certified by the Secretary of the Department of Minerals and Energy to have a specialised application and is specifically designed for technical use in Operations or Joint Operations on the Kutubu Petroleum Development Project, Southern Highlands and Gulf Provinces.
