


**PUBLIC NOTICE**

I, SEREI ERI, G.C.M.G., K. St. J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Sections 1, 2 and 3 of the *Public Holidays Act* (Chapter 321) and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council hereby:—

- (a) appoint Monday 15th June, 1992 to be the day to commemorate the birthday of the Queen; and
- (b) appoint Wednesday 16th September, 1992 to be the day to commemorate the attainment of Independent Sovereign Nationhood; and
