

INDEPENDENT STATE OF PAPUA NEW GUINEA

No. 19 of 1991

AN ACT

entitled

Insurance (Amendment) Act 1991.

Being an Act to amend the *Insurance Act* (Chapter 255),

MADE by the National Parliament to come into operation in accordance with a notice in the *National Gazette* by the Head of State, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the Minister.

1. COMPLIANCE WITH CONSTITUTIONAL REQUIREMENTS.

This Act, to the extent that it regulates or restricts a right or freedom referred to in Subdivision III.3.C (*qualified rights*) of the Constitution, namely—

- (a) the right to freedom from arbitrary search and entry conferred by Section 44 of the Constitution; and
- (b) the right to privacy conferred by Section 49 of the Constitution,

is a law that is made for the purpose of giving effect to the public interest in public welfare.

2. NEW PART VII.

The Principal Act is amended by adding the following new Parts:—

“PART VII.—ALL RISKS SITUATED IN PAPUA NEW GUINEA TO BE INSURED WITH LICENSED INSURERS.”

“40. ALL RISKS SITUATED IN PAPUA NEW GUINEA TO BE INSURED WITH LICENSED INSURERS.”

(1) All risks situated in Papua New Guinea and for which insurance, other than re-insurance, is required shall be insured with licensed insurers unless exemption is granted under Section 41.

“(2) A person who—

- (a) insures; or
- (b) as agent, arranges insurance of,

a risk situated in Papua New Guinea with a person other than a licensed insurer, except in accordance with an exemption under Section 41, is guilty of an offence.

Penalty: A fine of K20 000.00 or of an amount equivalent to the gross annual premium in respect of that risk effected outside Papua New Guinea, whichever is the greatest.

“41. EXEMPTION.

(1) Where the Commissioner is satisfied that the existing facilities and available capacity of licensed insurers are fully utilized he may, on application in accordance with Subsection (2), grant to a person an exemption from the provisions of Section 40.

“(2) An application for an exemption under Subsection (1) shall—

- (a) be made in writing to the Commissioner no later than 14 days prior to the date on and from which the insurance is required; and
- (b) contain information in support of the application to show that the existing facilities and available capacity of licensed insurers are fully utilized; and
- (c) contain particulars of the proposed arrangements to insure the risk outside Papua New Guinea.

“(3) The Commissioner shall consider an application under Subsection (2) and—

- (a) may grant an exemption or refuse to grant an exemption; and
- (b) shall advise the applicant in writing of his decision under Paragraph (a) not later than seven days prior to the date on and from which the insurance is required.

“(4) An exemption granted under this section may be subject to such conditions as the Commissioner considers appropriate.

“(5) No funds in respect of any premium for insurance to which this Part relates may be remitted outside Papua New Guinea unless and until written advice of an exemption has been received by an applicant for exemption.

“42. INSPECTION.

(1) Where the Commissioner is of the opinion that a person may have contravened the provisions of this Part, he, or a person authorized by him in writing, may—

“42. Inspection.—continued

- (a) require that person to produce any premium receipts, cover notes, insurance policies or other papers relating to insurance placed by that person or on that person's behalf; and
- (b) inspect any such premium receipts, cover notes, insurance policies or other papers produced; and
- (c) take copies of any such premium receipts, cover notes, insurance policies or other papers.

“(2) A person who—

- (a) hinders or obstructs the Commissioner, or a person authorized by the Commissioner, in the exercise or performance of his powers and functions under Subsection (1); or
- (b) without lawful excuse (proof of which is on him)—
 - (i) refuses or wilfully neglects to produce; or
 - (ii) refuses to allow the Commissioner, or a person authorized by him to make copies of, any premium receipts, cover note, insurance policy or other papers,
 is guilty of an offence.

Penalty: In the case of an offence by a natural person, a fine not exceeding K1 000.00 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding two years, or both; in the case of an offence by a person other than a natural person, a fine not exceeding K10 000.00.”

3. TRANSITIONAL PROVISION.

Any insurance to which Part VII of the Principal Act applies in force immediately before the date of the coming into operation of the *Insurance (Amendment) Act 1991* may continue in force without being in contravention of Part VII of the Principal Act until the expiry of—

(a) the policy of insurance; or

(b) 12 months from the date of the coming into operation of the *Insurance (Amendment) Act 1991*,

whichever shall first happen.

4. REPEAL.

The *Insurance (Amendment) Act 1981* is repealed.
