APPOINTMENT OF PUBLIC HOLIDAY

I, WIWA KOROWI, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 5 of the *Public Holidays Act* (Chapter 321) and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby appoint 25th April, 1992 to be a public holiday throughout Papua New Guinea to commemorate the 50th Anniversary Celebrations of World War Two.

**REVOCATION OF APPOINTMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF A DAY TO COMMEMORATE
THE BIRTHDAY OF THE QUEEN**

- (a) revoke the notice dated 2nd September, 1991 and published in the *National Gazette* No. G79 of 9th September, 1991 appointing Monday, 15th June, 1992 to be a day to commemorate the birthday of the Queen; and
- (b) appoint Monday, 8th June, 1992 to be a public holiday to commemorate the birthday of the Queen.
