Organic Law on Certain Constitutional Office-holders

RE-APPOINTMENT OF AUDITOR-GENERAL

I, WIWA KOROWI, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 213 of the Constitution and Section 13 of the *Organic Law on Certain Constitutional Office-holders* and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, given after receiving reports from the Public Services Commission and the Public Accounts Committee, hereby reappoint Makena Geno as Auditor-General for a period of six years commencing on and from 17th January, 1992.
