THE Right Honourable, the Prime Minister, Sir Julius Chan, To move—

PAGES 40—CLAUSE 44 (AMENDMENT OF SECTION 110)

Delete Paragraphs (b) and (c) and substitute the following:—

"(b) by repealing Subsection (5) and replacing it with the following:—

"(5) An Act of the Parliament shall make the provision for other functions and powers of, and other matters relating to the Authority and the administrative and staffing arrangements for and in respect of the Inspectorates; and

"(c) by adding after Subsection (5) the following subsection:-


"(6) An Act of the Parliament shall-

(a) make provision for and in respect of the office of the Director-General of the Authority, including the manner of appointment and the terms and conditions of the employment and the functions of the Director-General; and

(b) establish a secretariat for and in respect of the Authority and specify the functions of the secretariat."
