**Cities Act (Chapter 4)**

**WARRANT**

**ESTABLISHING THE CITY OF MOUNT HAGEN**

WHEREAS it is provided by Section 2 of the *Cities Act* (Chapter 4) that the Head of State, acting on advice, may, by Warrant, declare an area to be a City provided that a Local Government Council exists for, or for an area including, that area and after he has regard as to whether the population of the area exceeds Fifteen thousand persons and the unimproved value of land within the area exceeds Ten Million Kina:

**Establishing the City of Mount Hagen—continued**

AND WHEREAS the Town of Mount Hagen, the boundaries of which are set out in the Schedule to this Warrant, is within the area of Mount Hagen Local Government Council and Mount Hagen Town Authority and has a population exceeding fifteen thousand persons and the unimproved value of the land within the Town exceeds Ten Million Kina:

NOW THEREFORE I, Arnold Amet Kt, C.B.E., Acting Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 2 of the *Cities Act* (Chapter 4) and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, declare the Town of Mount Hagen to be a City under the name of the City of Mount Hagen, and I do further declare that the boundaries of the City of Mount Hagen shall be as set out in the Schedule to this Warrant.
