Customs Tariff Act 1990

EXEMPTION FROM IMPORT DUTY

I, Rabbie Namaliu, K.C.M.G., MP., Acting Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 9(1)(a) of the *Customs Tariff Act 1990* and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby, with effect from 21st March, 1996 exempt from payment of import duty the goods specified in the Schedule subject to such conditions as are specified in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

Goods:— Plants, machinery, equipment, component and materials, other than those locally produced or manufactured, required for the construction and operation of the Bereina-Malalaua Road Construction Project for the period from March, 1996 to 21st March, 2000.

Conditions:—

- (1) That the Commissioner-General, in consultation with the Secretary of the Department of Transport and Works, is satisfied that the goods are covered under the Agreement with the China National Overseas Engineering Corporation of Beijing, China and will be for use solely in the construction of the Bereina-Malalaua Construction Project; and
- (2) That, in satisfaction of Clause (1) above, Certificate(s) is issued by the Commissioner-General of the Internal Revenue Commission and the Secretary for the Department of Transport and Works in respect of those goods; and
- (3) That bonds are to be provided in an amount equal to the value of each and every good imported, for the purpose of the Agreement; of import duties of the said goods, and the said bonds to remain valid for the duration of the term of the Agreement or until the re-export of the said goods, whichever first occurs.
