Curfew Act 1987

PROCLAMATION OF CURFEW

I, Wiwa Korowi, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the *Curfew Act 1987* and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby require every person with the boundaries of—

- (a) Central Province (being the area specified as Central Province in the Organic Law on Provincial Boundaries); and
- (b) the National Capital District (being the area specified in the Organic Law on the Boundaries of the National Capital District),

to remain within doors between the hours of ten o'clock in the evening (10.00 p.m.) and four o'clock in the morning (4.00 a.m.) for a period commencing on and from ten o'clock in the evening (10.00 p.m.) on Wednesday 8th January, 1997 until four o'clock in the morning (4.00 a.m.) on Saturday 8th March, 1997.
