RE-APPOINTMENT OF GOVERNOR OF THE BANK OF PAPUA NEW GUINEA

CONSTITUTION

Public Services (Management) Act 1995

REVOCATION OF ACTING APPOINTMENT AND PROMOTION AND APPOINTMENT OF DEPARTMENTAL HEAD

- I, Wiwa Korowi, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 193 of the Constitution and Sections 25, 27 and 31 of the *Public Services (Management) Act* 1995, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, given after consultation with the Public Services Commission, thereby—
 - (a) revoke the appointment of Isaac Lupari as Acting Secretary, Department of Finance; and
 - (b) promote and appoint Isaac Lupari to be Departmental Head of the Department of Finance for a period of 4 years,

commencing on and from the date of publication of this instrument in the National Gazette.
