Organic Law on Certain Constitutional Office-holders

APPOINTMENT OF ACTING AUDITOR-GENERAL

I, Silas Atopare, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 213 of the Constitution and Section 18 of the *Organic Law on Certain Constitutional Office-holders* and all other powers enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, given after receiving reports from the Public Services Commission and the Public Accounts Committee, hereby appoint Lobe Ura Geno as acting Auditor-General for a period commencing on and from 2nd November, 1998 up to and including 20th November, 1998 during the absence of Mark M. Wani on overseas leave.

Civil Aviation Act (Chapter 239)

Organic Law on Provincial Governments and Local-level Governments

APPOINTMENT OF CHAIRMAN AND MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL ECONOMIC AND FISCAL COMMISSION

I, Silas Atopare, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 187H(1) of the Constitution and Section 117 of the *Organic Law on Provincial Governments and Local-level Governments*, and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby appoint the following persons to be members of the National Fiscal Commission:—

- (a) under Section 117(2)(a) of the *Organic Law*, Nao Badu, who shall be Chairman of the Commission; and
 - (b) under Section 117(2)(b) of the *Organic Law*, Rex Pake, a qualified accountant; and
 - (c) under Section 117(2)(c) of the *Organic Law*, Mel Togolo, an economist; and
 - (d) under Section 117(2)(e) of the *Organic Law*, Peter Bogosia, a qualified engineer nominated by the Society of Professional Engineers; and
 - (e) under Section 117(2)(f) of the *Organic Law*, Dr Colin Filer, a social researcher from the National Research Institute; and
 - (f) under Section 117(2)(g) of the *Organic Law*, Morea Vele, the Governor of the Bank of Papua New Guinea; and
 - (g) under Section 117(2)(h) of the *Organic Law*, Camillus Midire, the Director of the Office responsible for planning matters; and
 - (h) under Section 117(2)(i) of the *Organic Law*, David Murray, a person nominated by the Minister; and
 - (i) under Section 117(2)(i) of the *Organic Law*, Nahau Rooney, a person nominated by the Minister,
- with effect on and from the date of publication of this instrument in the *National Gazette*.
