5. The Company is indebted to the Petitioner for the sum of K15,000.00 being the amount due for goods sold and delivered to the Company by the Petitioner between April and May, 1997.
6. Your Petitioner has made repeated applications to the Company for payment of the debt referred to in paragraph 5 hereof but the Company has failed or neglected to pay or satisfy the same.
7. The grounds upon which the Petitioner relies in support of this Petition for the winding-up of the Company are as follows:—
 - (a) The Company is unable to pay its debts;
 - (b) it is just and equitable that the Company be wound-up.

1. That Osenia Construction Pty Ltd may be wound-up by the Court under the provisions of the *Companies Act*.
2. Or that such other order may be made in the premises as shall be just.
