## SUSPENSION OF POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE NATIONAL CAPITAL DISTRICT COMMISSION

I, Silas Atopare, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 32(1) of the *National Capital District Commission Act 1990* and all other powers me enabling, acting with and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, given after considering a report from the Committee of Inquiry and a statement by the Minister of his reasons for appointing a Committee of Inquiry, hereby, with effect on and from 12.01 a.m. on 7th September 1999, suspend for an indefinite period all the powers and functions of the National Capital District Commission.
