REVOCATION AND APPOINTMENT OF CHAIRMAN, DEPUTY CHAIRMAN, MEMBERS AND ALTERNATE MEMBERS OF THE INDUSTRIAL CENTRE DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION BOARD

I, Hon. Michael Nali, Minister for Trade and Industry, by virtue of the powers conferred by Sections 9, 10 and 11 of the *Industrial Centres Development Corporation Act 1990* and all other powers me enabling, hereby—

- (a) revoke the appointment of each persons specified in Column 1 of Schedule 1 to cease to be a member and Alternate member of the Industrial Centres Development Corporation Board appointed under the provision specified in Column 2 of the Schedule opposite his name.
- (b) revoke the appointment of Michael Maue, as the Chairman of the ICDC Board.
- (c) appoint each person specified in Column 1 of the Schedule 2 to be a member of the Industrial Centres Development Corporation Board appointed under the provision specified in Column 2 of the Schedule opposite his name and each person specified in Column 3 of the Schedule to be the Alternate member of the Board for the member opposite his name for a period of two years; and
- (d) appoint James Mand to be the Chairman and Hagai Joshua to be the Deputy Chairman of the Industrial Centres Development Corporation Board for a period of two years,

with effect on and from the date of publication of this instrument in the *National Gazette*.
