Cemeteries Act (Chapter 302)

LICENSING FOR PRIVATE BURIAL GROUND

I, Andrew Kumbakor, Minister for Provincial and Local Government Affairs, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 5 of the *Cemeteries Act* (Chapter 302), and all other powers me enabling, hereby license the United Church in Papua New Guinea to use the land describled in Schedule 1 hereto ("the cemetery") for burials subject to the conditions set out in Schedule 2 hereto.

SCHEDULE 1

All and Whole that piece of land extending to 0.05 hectares or thereabouts situated at and forming part of Section 64, Lot 35, Boroko in the National Capital District being the north-easternmost corner of the said section at a point being the northernmost corner of the said cemetery thence in a south-easterly direction on a bearing of 149 degrees 42 minutes and 10 seconds for 26 metres thence in an easterly direction on a bearing of 234 degrees 56 minutes for 27 metres, thence by the existing corner boundary of the said section.

SCHEDULE 2

Conditions pertaining to the Licence

- 1. The cemetery shall be for the burial of Reverend Sione Kami and one other.
- 2. Each Allotment in which a body is buried shall be marked with the name and date of death of the person buried there.
- 3. A burial shall only take place in accordance with the requisites for burial as set out in Section 21 of the Cemeteries Act (Chapter 302).
- 4. Notice shall be given to the Registration Officer of every person buried in the cemetery.
- 5. The Council of Boroko United Church shall maintain a plan of the cemetery and a record of the date of each burial and of the name of the person buried.
