I, Silas Atopare, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 46(2) of the *Industrial Relations Act* (Chapter 174) and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby declare the Award No. 13 of 1997 a Memorandum of Agreement entered into between the Employers Federation of Papua New Guinea and Papua New Guinea Trade Union Congress, published in the *National Gazette* No. G96 of November 1997, to be declared a Common Rule. The Common Rule Declaration calls for a 7.5% increase on the National Minimum Wages of K22.96 and National Youth Wage of K17.22 per week.

Declaration of Common Rule—continued

The Common Rule is now applicable to employers and employees who are not members of PNG Trade Union and the Employers Federation of PNG. The Common Rule covers 7.5% adjustment to the National Minimum Wage of K22.96 and National Youth Wage of K17.22 per week as in Schedule below.

National Minimum Wage K24.68 per week.

National Minimum Youth Wage K18.51 per week.
