NOTICE OF MORATORIUM ON ISSUE OF FIREARM LICENCES

I, Mathias Karani, Minister for Police, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 5A(1) of the *Firearms Act* (Chapter 310) and all other powers me enabling, declare a moratorium during which no new licences or permits shall be issued for the following firearms:—

Shotguns

Pistols

High-powered firearms,

for an indefinite period effective from date of this gazettal.

Firearms Act (Chapter 310)

NOTICE OF FIREARM AND AMMUNITION AMNESTY

I, Mathias Karani, Minister for Police, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 79(1) of the *Firearms Act* (Chapter 310) and all other powers me enabling, declare that where:—

(a) a person surrenders to an officer of the Police—

- (i) a firearm, pistol or high-powered firearm which is unlicensed or of which he is not the licence holder; or
- (ii) ammunition which he is not authorised to have in his possession; or

(b) a person—

- (i) voluntarily declares to a commissioned officer of the Police that he is in possession of an unlicensed firearm or unlicensed pistol;

that person is not liable to prosecution under the *Firearms Act* arising of his possession of that firearm, pistol or high-powered firearm or ammunition.

Notice of Firearm and Ammunition Amnesty—continued

The declaration is made for a period of six months and applies to the whole country effective from date of this gazettal.
