National Road Safety Council Act 1997

REVOCATION OF APPOINTMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF CHAIRMAN, DEPUTY CHAIRMAN AND MEMBERS AND ALTERNATE MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL ROAD SAFETY COUNCIL

I, Bart Philemon, Minister for Transport and Civil Aviation, by virtue of the powers conferred by Sections 6(2), 7 and 8(1) of the *National Road Safety Council Act 1997* and all other powers me enabling, hereby—

(a) revoke —

- (i) the appointment of Philip Kwalu and Klei Kera as members and Frank Aku and Simon Sabu as alternate members, under Section 6(b)(i) and (ii) of the *National Road Safety Council Act 1997* respectively, as published in *National Gazette* No. G155 of 17th December, 1998; and
- (ii) the appointment of Klei Kera as Chairman and Michael Mayberry as Deputy Chairman under Section 8(1) of the *National Road Safety Council Act 1997* respectively, as published in the *National Gazette* No. G46 of 1st April, 1999; and

(b) appoint—

- (i) each person specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to be a member of the National Road Safety Council under the section of the Act specified in Column 2 and set out opposite the name of that person; and
- (ii) each person specified in Column 3 of the Schedule to be the alternate member on that Board for the member specified in Column 1 of the Schedule and set out opposite the name of that person; and
- (iii) Bernard Kipit a member of the Council as Chairman and Vallipuram Puvanachandran a member of the Council as Deputy Chairman of the National Road Safety Council under Section 8(1) of the *National Road Safety Council Act 1997*,

for a period of three years commencing on and from the date of signature of this instrument.
