National Capital District Commission Act 2001

APPOINTMENT OF CHAIRMAN, DEPUTY CHAIRMAN AND MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL CAPITAL DISTRICT COMMISSION

I, Silas Atopare, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred:—

- (a) by Sections 5(b) and 10 of the Act, and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby appoint to be members of the National Capital District Commission:—
- (i) Rose Kekedo to represent Women; and
 - (ii) Archbishop Brian Barns to represent Churches; and
 - (iii) Thomas Tanasu to represent Business and Professional groups; and
 - (iv) Opao Udia to represent Youths; and
 - (v) John King to represent Trade Unions,
- for a period of three months; and
- (b) by Sections 5(c) and 10 of the Act, and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby appoint Kunai Tomba to be a member of the National Capital District Commission to represent settlements for a period of three months; and
- (c) by Section 6 of the Act, and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby appoint Thomas Tanasu to be Chairman and Rahe Maraki Rau, Chairman of the Motu Koitabu Council, to be the Deputy Chairman of the National Capital District Commission,
- with effect on and from the date of publication of this instrument in the *National Gazette*.
