*Customs Tariff Act 1990***EXEMPTION FROM IMPORT DUTY**

I, Silas Atopare, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 9(1)(a) of the *Customs Tariff Act 1990* and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, exempt from import duty the new, used, modified and/or refurbished goods comprising those goods and materials specified for purposes of construction and operation of the Wewak Tuna processing facility by South Seas Tuna Corporation Limited and any other associated and ancillary goods, materials, assets, plant, equipment, consumables and spare and replacement parts and related expenses imported into Papua New Guinea for the purposes of construction, implementation and operation of the tuna processing plant at Wewak as provided for in the said Project Agreement including—

- (a) all goods referred to in Clause 7.2, 10.2 and Schedule 3 of the Project Agreement between the Independent State of Papua New Guinea, East Sepik Provincial Government and South Seas Tuna Corporation Limited dated 5th July, 2000; and**
- (b) all goods, plant, equipment, assets and other materials, supplies, consumables and related expenses, spare parts and other items required for construction and operation of the processing facility and the South Seas Vessels and associated goods, plant, equipment, materials, supplies, consumables, replacement parts, spare parts and other items as is necessary for construction commencement and carrying out of commercial operations under the said Project Agreement except goods and equipment that—**
 - (i) are not a necessary or incidental part of the Processing Facility; and**
 - (ii) are ordinarily available to the Company in PNG as required by and in accordance with Clause 10.1,**

with effect on and from 5th July, 2000, being the date of execution of Project Agreement between the Independent State of Papua New Guinea, South Seas Tuna Corporation Limited and East Sepik Provincial Government.
